## **Order Picker License British Columbia**

Order Picker License British Columbia - Order picking is otherwise called order preparation operation. This is one of the key processes within a warehouse and consists of people called order pickers, collecting and taking articles in a certain quantity previous to shipment in order to accomplish customer orders. Order picking is a simple warehousing method. The effectiveness in which this job is completed could be directly connected to the productivity of a supply chain. Therefore, order picking is one of the most controlled logistic processes. Order picking falls within the category of the warehouse management system.

There are particular kinds of order picking which comprise: pick to box method, wave picking method, piece picking or picker to part method, zone picking method and sorting systems method.

The pick to box method comprises the order picker just filling the boxes with item that are from their particular station. The box then moves on to other locations to until the order is finish. In this process, there is no movement of the order picker personnel. In the wave picking method, the order pickers move all-around in order to collect the required things for some orders. The picker to part method or piece picking is similar where the order picker or pickers move to gather the items needed but for one order only.

In the sorting systems method, there is no movement of the order picking workers. Instead, the things are brought to her or him through an automated system like automatic storage or a conveyor system. In the zone picking method, each and every order picker is assigned to one particular zone. They are responsible for only realizing order picking in this specified area.
