Aerial Lift Training British Columbia - An aerial work platform is a mechanical access platform. This particular device provides access to otherwise not accessible places for equipment or people. Likewise known as an aerial device or elevating work platform, the machinery is often utilized to be able to access high places. Construction and maintenance staff normally have to use aerial work platforms on the job. Firefighters utilize them for emergency access.

The aerial work platform is meant to temporary use, providing access to high areas. They are designed to be operated by one person, with the capability of lifting weights of not more than one ton. Some types have higher load limits. There are different kinds of aerial work platforms; like for instance, there is a "cherry picker" and a "scissor lift".

Some aerial work platforms are available outfitted together with compressed air connectors for power tools or electrical outlets. For specialist jobs, such as lifting frames for window glass, an aerial work platform may come together with special equipment.

Anybody required to operate an aerial lifting machinery requires training, along with their bosses. Members of Health & Safety Committees and representatives responsible for inspecting aerial machine work places also must go through training. Trainees would know how to use an aerial lift device. They will also gain an understanding of the regulations that apply to safely using these machines. Rules differ in different provinces, and within worksites that are federally regulated.

Anyone who is required to be lifted by or work near an aerial lifting machine must be informed about potential hazards. An Aerial Lift Training Video can be shown in a general safety session to educate all of the employees who are lifted by them or work near them.

Most Aerial Lift Training Program would consist of modules that are focused on the following areas: hazard Identification; Aerial Lift Devices and Operating Controls; Platform Positioning & Park Positioning and Pre Operational Checks for Aerial Lift Devices. The particular program is intended to train workers on the safe operation of self-propelled, elevated work platforms and boom supported, self-propelled, elevated work platforms. Employees who complete the program would be given a certificate, signed by a qualified individual to confirm successfully finishing a hands-on practical exam.
