Zoom Boom Ticket British Columbia - Zoom Boom Training is intended to train operators on variable reach forklifts. The goals of the training are to be able to impart an understanding of the physics of the machinery, and to be able to outline the operator's tasks. This program abides by North American safety standards for lift trucks. Zoom boom training and certification is obtainable at our site or at the company's location, provided there are a few individuals training. Certification given upon successful completion is good for three years.

The telehandler or also known as a telescopic handler is similar in various ways to a crane and a common forklift. This versatile machine is made along with a telescopic boom that could extend forward and lift upwards. Various attachments could be connected on the end of the boom, such as pallet forks, bucket, muck grab or lift table. It is popular in agriculture and industry settings.

The telehandler is a common utilized together with fork attachments to be able to allow the transporting of loads. Telehandlers have the advantage of being able to reach those inaccessible places which cannot be reached by a standard forklift. Telehandlers are capable of removing loads which are palletized from inside a trailer and placing them on high places such as rooftops. For certain applications, they could be much more practical and efficient compared to a crane.

The disadvantage of the telehandler is its unsteadiness when lifting loads which are heavier. When the boom extends with a load, the unit becomes ever more unstable. Counterweights located at the back help, but don't solve the problem. As the working radius increases, the lifting capacity quickly decreases. Several equipment come with front outriggers which extend the lifting capacity while the equipment is stationary.
