Telehandler Certification British Columbia - A telehandler certification program can be taken by prospective operators who have previous experience with driving typical forklifts and for individuals with no previous experiences on a lift truck. The real-world training offered by these programs produces graduates well versed in the safe and right use of these types of equipment.

Telehandler certification programs could be finished at a third party location or at the work site of the trainees. In order to get the formal training at a specific training facility, the manufacturer could work out a licensing agreement to bring other people to a training facility. This alternative offers those training with the chance to learn to utilize the machines in a controlled setting. When completed, participants receive a certification or license to operate this kind of machine.

With the latter alternative, a qualified instructor is sent to a work location to provide on-location training. This alternative ensures that the trainee is instructed on actual machinery that will be used on the job, and prepares the trainee for the demands of that particular environment. People training learn about potentially dangerous situations that can occur on the actual work location. The instruction focuses on any situation that are specific to the work location, enabling operators to be ready to deal with these elements more safely.

"Telehandler" is an abbreviated version of the term "telescopic handler," that references the equipment's extending or telescoping arm supporting a fork. The controls and characteristics of the telehandler are somewhat like a lift truck. A telehandler has the capability of transporting and lifting loads up and away from the vehicle. Improper operation of telehandlers can cause serious accidents. If load limitations are exceeded, the equipment can tip due to excess weight on the lift. It is the task of the operator to understand load limits and to use these machines safely.

Telehandler programs designed for operators who are already certified to utilize a forklift are referred to as "conversion" classes. These classes teach the differences between telehandlers and forklifts, and avoid repeating information that forklift operators already know. For trainees who have no past experience utilizing telehandler machinery, training covers the basic operation and utilization of the machinery. Some organizations provide refresher programs as well.
